Estates benefitted to be assessed according to law.

about 1850 ft.

In Worthington St. about 350 ft.

In Lexington Ave. from Worthington St. to near Brattle St.
about 1500 ft.

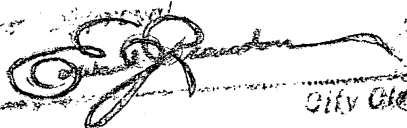

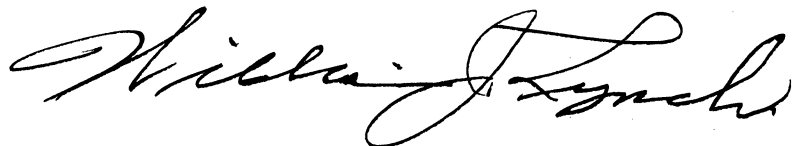
