- WHEREAS: The Vineyard Christian Fellowship of Cambridge was started in order to help people in Greater Boston have better, richer lives — particularly people who haven't previously connected well with churches; and
- WHEREAS: Vineyard Christian Fellowship began inauspiciously in 1974 as a young man named Kenn Gulliksen led a small fellowship of burned-out Christians in the Los Angeles area; and
- WHEREAS: The mission of the Vineyard Christian Fellowship is to Empower Impossibly Great Lives; and
- WHEREAS: Vineyard churches have become known for helping people find a fresh experience of God in an informal, contemporary setting. Many Vineyard songs are sung worldwide, across many denominations, in keeping with a vision not only to build up Vineyard churches, but also to bless and encourage as many churches and denominations as possible; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record extending its best wishes to the Vineyard Christian Fellowship as it has moved into its new place of worship located at 170 Rindge Avenue; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Vineyard Christian Fellow on behalf of the entire City Council.
