The Mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Association endorses the plans proposed by the Inman Square Beautification Committee for alterations to Inman Square with the understanding that the changes in the square will not be detrimental to traffic flow. We note that continued non-enforcement of the no parking zone adjacent to the fire house could create chaos if the street were narrowed and those presently parking in those illegal spaces continued to do so.
