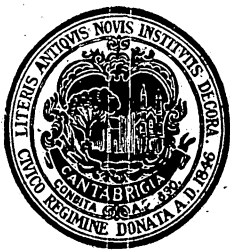

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN

July 22, 1913.

Ordered,

That a City Debt be Created

for the sum of **Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00)**
for the purpose of **the construction of an Engine House and Fire Alarm Station on the city land in Inman Square, on the site of Engine House No. 5 in this city, and for paying all expenses incident thereto, as authorized by Chapter 27 of the Revised Laws of this Commonwealth,**

and that from time to time as the City Treasurer may deem necessary bonds of the City will be issued not exceeding that amount, either in the form of registered or coupon bonds, one or both, to be styled

BUILDING LOAN

said bonds to be dated at the ~~date of their issue~~ **July 1, 1913** and payable **Fifty-five hundred on July 1st of each year 1914 to 1923 both included.**

~~years from said date~~, with interest at the rate of not exceeding **4½** per centum per annum, payable semi-annually; that the Mayor, City Auditor and City Treasurer be and are hereby authorized and instructed to sign and execute said bonds and all transfers and exchanges of the same in the manner directed by the ordinances of the City, and that the City Treasurer be and is hereby directed to bargain and sell, and is hereby authorized to transfer and exchange the same.
