- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to require the petitioner to post a bond in an amount sufficient to cover any claims against the City arising out of the conduct of this business and to specify any conditions or restrictions which he deems necessary to protect the safe passage and safety of the public in this area and further, ensure that the license shall conform to all statutes and ordinances of the City of Cambridge now in effect; and shall have the right to revoke said permit if he deems that any violation of this order exists.

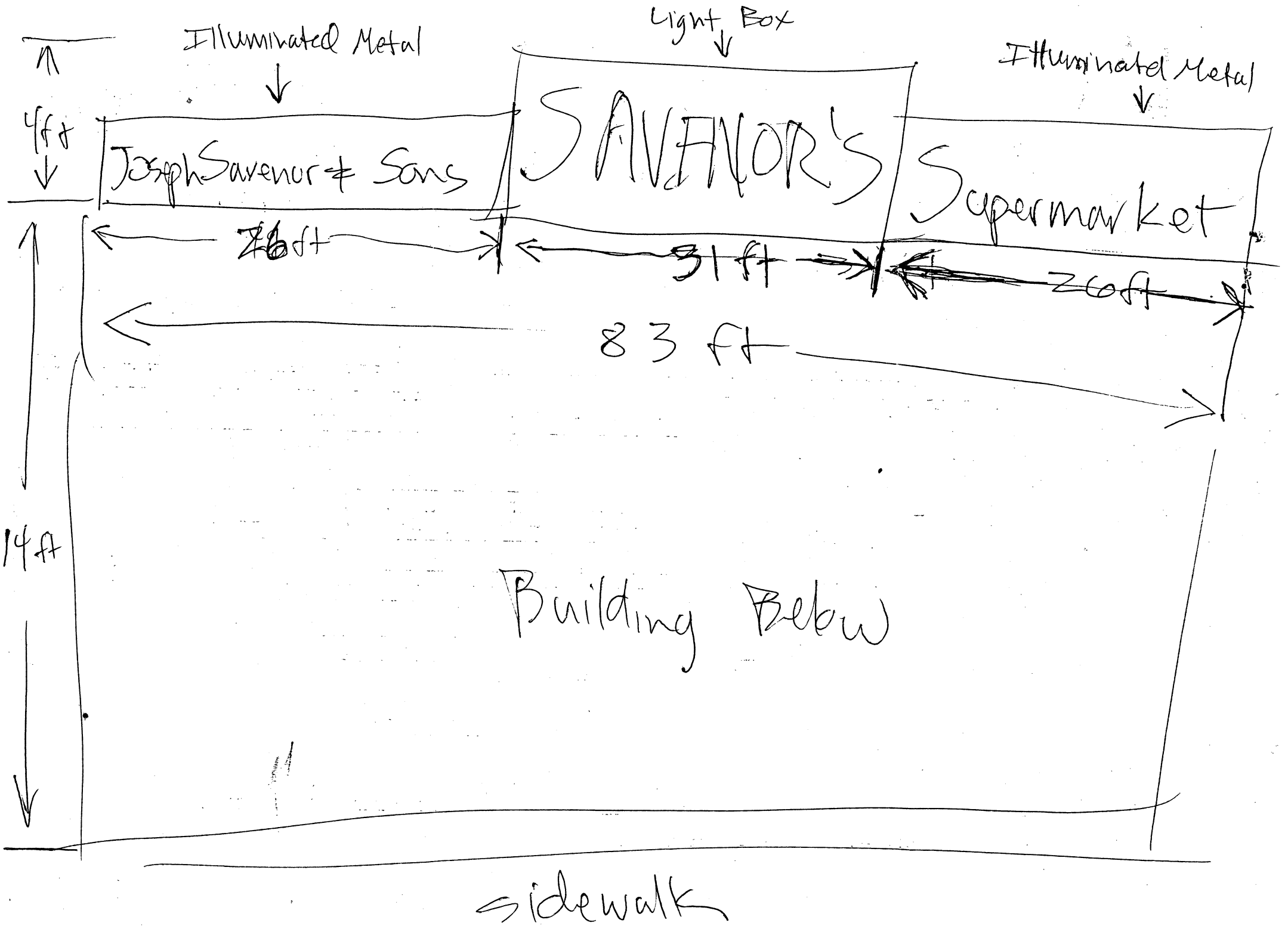
