We recently received notice that the City's Application for Direct Appellate Review in the Flynn case has been accepted by the Supreme Judicial Court. We had refrained from filing a brief in the Appeals Court on the case in the hope that the SJC would accept the application, and we will now have until November 12 to file a brief. As in the Superior Court case, I will be working on the brief with Hans Loeser and Stephen Deutsch.

We are very pleased that the Supreme Judicial Court has granted direct appellate review, since the Court's decision will provide the city with a definitive determination of the validity of Ordinance 926.

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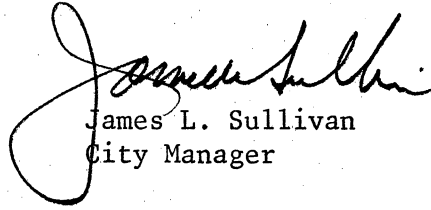
