To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$83,333 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary & Wages Account (\$61,230.30), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$20,769.70), and Travel & Training Account (\$1,333) from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health. This appropriation will allow the Cambridge Prevention Coalition to reduce alcohol use by Cambridge youth ages 12-17 by implementing a science-based environmental strategy to address both community norms and underage access to alcohol. The funds will be used to cover a portion of the salaries of three staff as well as program operating costs and training.
