A small group of Task Force members will tour the Gately Shelter and the Moore Center (as examples of Multi- Service centers) and report back to the full Task Force at it's next meeting (October 8, 1991)

## COUNCILLOR TOOMEY

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge Department of Human Services is seeking to move the East Cambridge Frisoli Teen Center to a site on First Street which would be a totally inappropriate location for a teen center; and

WHEREAS: The East Cambridge Planning Team Committee has for many years attempted to develop a multipurpose community center in East Cambridge which would provide services to every resident of East Cambridge from toddler to adolescent to teen to adult to senior citizens; and

WHEREAS: The East Cambridge Planning Team Committee has shown its intense and sincere interest in providing coordinated community services by setting aside funds for a community center; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has provided the residents of North Cambridge with the Gately Shelter, the residents of Riverside/Cambridgeport with the Willis Moore Community Center and will soon be providing the residents of Area 4 with a Community Center; now therefore be it...

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to form the East Cambridge Community Center Task Force including representatives of the East Cambridge Planning Team Committee, the East Cambridge Frisoli Teen Center (including parents, teens and staff), Truman, Putnam and Miller River Apartments, Kennedy Neighborhood Council, and other appropriate agencies and organizations or interested residents and the Assistant City Managers for Human Services and Community Development; and be it further

ORDERED: That this Task Force be empowered to develop and implement plans and programs to be operated in an East Cambridge Community Center to be funded with City, State, Federal and private funds in an appropriate location in East Cambridge; and be it further

ORDERED: That the Task Force report back to this City Council by September 30, 1991 on its progress in establishing an East Cambridge Community Center.

Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.
