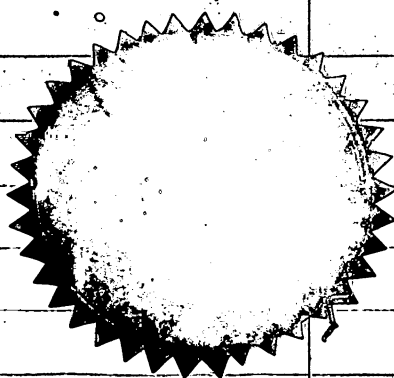

In consideration whereof the said City of Cambridge hereby promises and agrees to and with the said Coolidge,

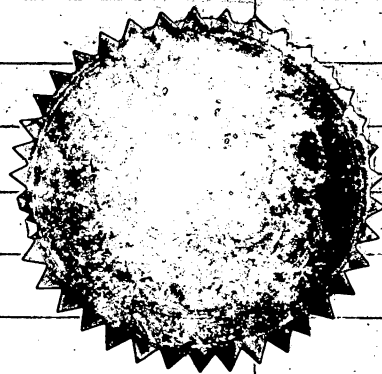
