In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 11, regarding the status of truck restrictions on Putnam Avenue, please be advised of the following:

The Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department has scheduled a vehicle count on Putnam Avenue during the week of March 25, 1996. The count will be taken between River Street and Sidney Street for at least a 24-hour period. After reviewing the count information, a determination will be made if a heavy commercial vehicle ban is warranted and, if so, during what hours. The engineering report will be prepared, if warranted, and submitted to the Massachusetts Highway Department for their approval by May, 1996.
