IN CITY COUNCIL

May 17, 1976

ORDERED:

On the petition of Frank Kombouras, that the Commissioner of Public Works be authorized under the provisions of the City Ordinances, to grant a permit or license to said Frank Kombouras to erect and maintain a mansard roof extending two feet over the sidewalk, for a distance of 80 feet, at the premises numbered 2416 Massachusetts Avenue.

Provided that, before erecting the above named mansard roof, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said mansard roof.
