In Common Council, June 27 1860

Ordered, That the Committee on Public Property be instructed to ascertain and report, whether a portion of the lot on which the City Stables stand, cannot be exchanged for a lot of equal size, adjacent to the Stables lot, and on Tremont Street, so as to make the northeasterly line of the City land, a straight line from Tremont Street to Norfolk Street.
