ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Director of Traffic and Parking, the Chief of Police and the Commissioner of Public Works to take the required action and issue the necessary permits in connection with the Annual Feast of the Holy Spirit sponsored by the Portuguese American Civic League of 26 Springfield Street, Somerville, during the period of Friday, Saturday and Sunday, July 6th, 7th and 8th, 1984, to accomplish the following:

1. Close Springfield Street on Friday, July 6, 1984 at 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m., provide the necessary escorts and traffic controls for the parade route from 26 Springfield Street, Somerville to Inman Square to Cambridge Street, to Portland Street, to 9 Marney Street, return to Berkshire Street, to Cambridge Street to Inman Square, to 26 Springfield Street for the band concert by the Saint Anthony's Band, which will be held until 11:00 p.m.
2. Saturday, July 7, 1984 from 1:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. baskets for the poor will be distributed and a block dance held on Springfield Street from 8:00 p.m. to Midnight requiring Springfield Street to be closed to traffic from 7:00 p.m. to Midnight.
3. Sunday, July 8, 1984 to close Springfield Street to Houghton Street during the period of 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., provide escort and traffic clearance for parade beginning at 10:30 a.m. from 26 Springfield Street, Somerville to Inman Square, to Cambridge Street, to Portland Street to Saint Anthony's Church for 11:00 a.m. Mass, then returning to Cambridge Street to Inman Square and back to 26 Springfield Street Somerville;

and be it further

ORDERED:

That any permits granted for street closures and parades and other festival activities are subject to the condition that fire lanes be kept open at all times for the safety of the public, as determined by the Chief of the Fire Department.

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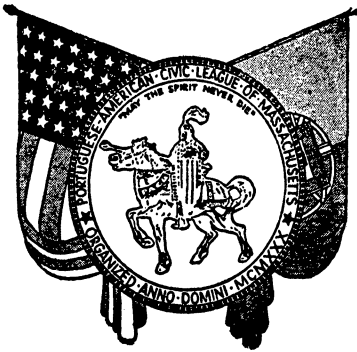

I would appreciate the following permits and closing of Springfield Street from Cambridge to Houghton Streets for the annual Feast of the Holy Spirit sponsored by the Portuguese American Civic League of 26 Springfield Street, Somerville to be held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, July 6, 7 and 8, 1984.

Friday, July 6, 1984 at 7:00 P.M., we will be leaving the club headquarters, 26 Springfield Street, Somerville to Inman Square, Cambridge to Cambridge Street, to Portland Street, to 9 Marney Street to pick up the Holy Ghost Crown. We will return to Berkshire Street to Cambridge Street, to Inman Square, to Springfield Street, and back to P.A.C.L. Headquarters. There will be a band concert till 11:00 P.M. by the St. Anthony's Band of Cambridge, Massachusetts. Street closed 7-11 P.M.

Saturday, July 7, 1984 at 1:30 P.M., we will distribute food baskets to the needy till 6:00 P.M. and hold a block dance from 8:00 P.M. till midnight. We request that Springfield Street from Cambridge Street to Houghton Street be closed to traffic from 7:00 P.M. till midnight.

Parade route Sunday July 8, 1984 will be starting at 10:30 A.M. from 26 Springfield Street, Somerville, to Inman Square, Cambridge, to Cambridge Street, to Portland Street, to St. Anthony's Church for the 11:00 A.M. Mass. After Mass return to Cambridge Street, to Inman Square and back to P.A.C.L. headquarters. There will be an auction and Band Concert by the St. John's Band of Stoughton, Massachusetts from 3:00 P.M. till 10:00 P.M.
