The undersigned respectfully pray

for permission for the MIT Tutoring Club to operate a mobile food vending truck on Ames Street in front of the Weisner Building.

We currently have a mobile food truck that is serving hot lunches at the MIT East Campus area. This venture was founded by the MIT Tutoring Club to raise funds for the math and science tutoring programs. The math and science classes, conducted by volunteering MIT students, are offered free of charge to refugee students of the Cambridge and Boston areas. The mobile food truck venture helps pay for books and supplies and field trips for the classes. Any surplus revenues at the end of the year are donated to Aid To Refugee Children W/o Parents Inc.

Right now we have permission from both MIT as well as the Cambridge License Commission (Richard Scali at x6140) to operate our food truck between the hours of 11:30 AM to 2:00 PM. We have had tremendous support from the MIT community, having gathered 2,000 signatures (1/4 of the MIT student body). We thus seek from the City Council special permission to stand for the 2 1/2 hours of operation rather than have to move every 10 minutes. We thank you for your special consideration to this matter.
