

An Ordinance  
Limiting the Compensation of the School Committee.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Sec. 1. The Members of the School Committee, shall receive one dollar, each, per day, for the time they are actually employed in discharging the duties of their office, as provided in the thirty eighth chapter of the General Statutes of the Commonwealth, and such sum shall be in full for all services rendered in such capacity.

Sec. 2. The Secretary of the School Committee shall receive seventy five dollars per year; and such sum shall be in full for all services rendered by him in said capacity of Secretary.

Sec. 3. No bill for compensation to the School Committee or any member thereof, shall be paid, unless the same shall have been submitted to the Mayor and Aldermen, and by them approved.
