

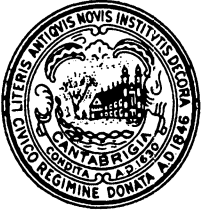



To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation transfer from the Reserve Fund Extraordinary Expenditures, to Rent Control Other Ordinary Maintenance, for \$22,750.00 is to pay the expenses of renting office space which was not included in the 1977-78 Budget. The Rent Control office had been scheduled for relocation to the City Hall Annex at the beginning of the fiscal year, but an analysis of their hearing room requirements would have required a complete revamping of the heating and ventilating system in the building. The offices have been relocated to a larger area at a lesser rent than the prior space.
