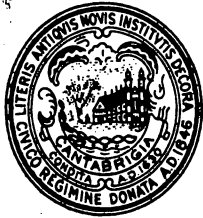


To the Honorable, the City Council:

As a result of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts notification to the School Department that a problem existed with asbestos in the War Memorial Building, the City engaged Camp, Dresser & McKee to conduct a facility rehabilitation study in order to determine the scope of the problem in removing the asbestos and restoring and upgrading the facility.

Attached is a copy of the report for your review. The School Department has also been furnished with a copy of the report.

It is my recommendation that the High School Loan Order be amended by increasing the loan authorization by 2 million dollars to a new authorization of 25.1 million dollars in order to accomplish the required asbestos removal.
