Two specific locations were mentioned: 114 Pearl Street and Williams and Magazine Street (owned by Dr. Malcolm Kates).

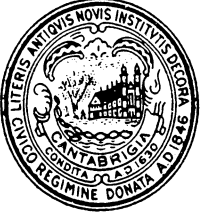
Kindly check these two locations immediately and, also, begin a systematic check of all locations in the Cambridgeport area.
