Proposed rulemaking concerning procedures for the determination of violations of G.L. c. 159A and G.L. c. 159B, and for the enforcement of the chapters, concerning transportation for hire of persons or property.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

Pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, Sec. 2, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") provides notice of its proposed regulations to establish procedures concerning the enforcement of the provisions of G.L. c. 159A and G.L. c. 159B.

The regulations proposed are designed to provide a systematic framework for the Department's ongoing enforcement activities that may include monetary penalties, while affording the subject of an enforcement action the opportunity to challenge any such action with full procedural safeguards.
