IN CITY COUNCIL

August 6, 1973

ORDERED:

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is requested to grant a permit to Northgate Construction Corporation to occupy a portion of the following public ways: premises numbered 219 to 227 Franklin Street, 27 to 31 Pearl Street and 220 to 228 Green Street during the period of construction of a parking garage, library and housing for the elderly.

Said permit to be granted upon the following conditions:

1. A barricade constructed of sturdy, steel chain link fence to be erected in the public ways suitably lighted as to prevent any injury to vehicles and pedestrians using these streets.
2. Said obstruction in occupancy no more than six feet of the public way and a minimum of twenty feet will be provided for the safe passage of the vehicles in the one way system that currently exists on the said streets.
3. The contractor to restore the existing sidewalk and road pavement to the condition it was prior to construction or to a better condition.
4. That the conditions herein specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge, who may, as he deems necessary, require traffic controls or the use of a policeman to facilitate the flow of traffic.
5. The contractor to file with the City Clerk a bond in the amount of \$25,000 indemnifying the city from any liability that may arise from the construction of said barricades.

DURING THE PERIOD OF CONSTRUCTION OF A PARKING GARAGE,
LIBRARY AND HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY.

1. A BARRICADE CONSTRUCTED OF STURDY STEEL CHAIN LINK FENCE TO BE ERECTED IN THE PUBLIC WAYS SUITABLY LIGHTED AS TO PREVENT ANY INJURY TO VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS USING THESE STREETS.
2. SAID OBSTRUCTION TO OCCUPY NO MORE THAN 6 FEET OF THE VEHICLE TRAVEL WAY AND A MINIMUM OF 20 FEET WILL BE PROVIDED FOR THE SAFE PASSAGE OF THE VEHICLES IN THE ONE WAY SYSTEM THAT CURRENTLY EXISTS ON THE SUBJECT STREETS.
3. THE CONTRACTOR TO RESTORE THE EXISTING SIDEWALK AND ROAD PAVEMENT TO THE CONDITION IT WAS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION OR TO A BETTER CONDITION.
4. THAT THE CONDITIONS HEREIN SPECIFIED SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE DIRECTOR OF TRAFFIC AND PARKING OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE. WHO MAY, AS HE DEEMS NECESSARY, REQUIRE TRAFFIC CONTROLS OR THE USE OF POLICEMAN TO FACILITATE THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC.
5. THE CONTRACTOR TO FILE WITH THE CITY CLERK A BOND INDEMNIFYING THE CITY FROM ANY LIABILITY THAT MAY ARISE FROM THE CONSTRUCTION OF SAID BARRICADES.
