- WHEREAS: In Council Session on September 19, 1988, an Order introduced by Councillor Duehay to rescind the policy contained in the City Council Order dated June 16, 1958 regarding the restrictions and conditions relating to the permanent easement granted to the City to maintain and operate a municipal parking lot underneath the Harvard Motor Inn and to adopt a new policy authorizing the City Council to make whatever restrictions and conditions it deemed advisable thereto was approved by a 5 to 4 vote of the Council; and
- WHEREAS: Said vote has the potential of being interpreted as an intention to extinguish an established easement which significantly affects the rights of a third party; and
- WHEREAS: To extinguish an established easement was not the purpose of the referenced Council vote; be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the City Solicitor to examine this issue and render his opinion thereof to this Council in writing on and no later than October 3, 1988, in order that any potential for extinguishing the easement, by misinterpretation of the referenced vote or by misinformation or misunderstanding of facts prior to the vote, may be given appropriate response by the members of this City Council.
