VICE-MAYOR RUSSELL

ORDERED: That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter Three, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Alan Jay Warner, President of A Jay, Inc., on behalf of Le Jardin for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk of the premises numbered 248 Huron Avenue on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Saturdays between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., and on Sundays between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. throughout the Spring, Summer and Fall seasons, provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and provided further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.

Dear Sirs,

This is a letter to request a permit to display items outside my retail store.

1. Business. Le Jardin is a fresh fruit, vegetable and flower market also selling dairy products and a small miscellaneous group of related items. We have been at this location since June 18, 1980. It is located in a building housing two other retail food stores (Formaggio Kithchen and The Fishmonger) at 248 Huron Ave. It is a neighborhood store largely serving this part of Cambridge although we do draw customers from all over the Boston area.

2. My Proposal. I would like to display potted plants, perennials and seasonal items such as pumpkins, apples and Christmas items in the space in front of my store. It will add to the attractiveness of the area and will not detract visually or practically from use of the sidewalk or access to the bus.

3. Hours and Days of Use. Our hours are 10am-7pm, Mondays through Fridays, 10am -6pm on Saturdays, 9:30am - 4pm on Sundays. We expect we would use this space a couple of hours before store opening to set up, and a couple of hours after store closing to put everything away.

I hope you will look favorably on this request so that Le Jardin may continue to grow in this lively business community in Cambridge.

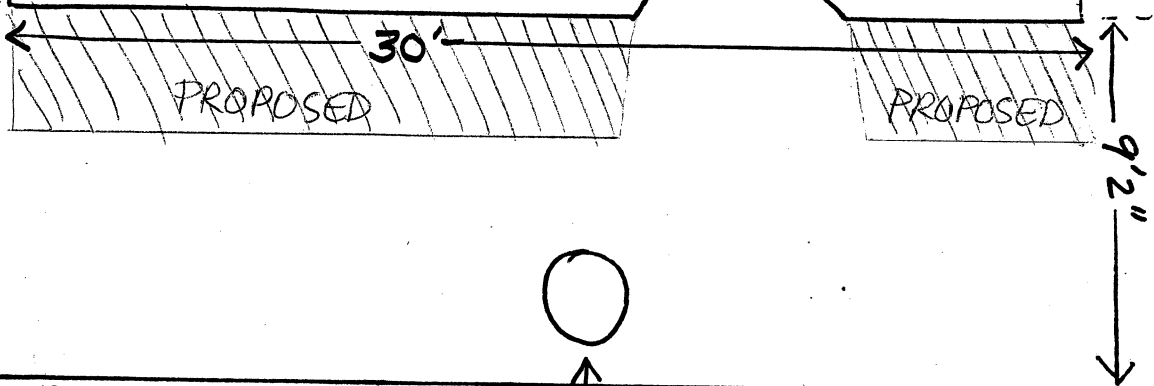
