- WHEREAS: 2001: A SPACE ODYSSEY, is a cinematic classic, selected for preservation in the National Film Registry of the Library of Congress; and
- WHEREAS: The Brattle Theatre is hosting a special screening of this film as part of its Tribute series, honoring the film and its late director Stanley Kubrick; and
- WHEREAS: Keir Dullea, the star of Kubrick's 2001: A SPACE ODYSSEY is joining the Brattle for an evening discussing the film and his work; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Dullea is an accomplished stage, film, and television actor, working not only with Kubrick but also such luminaries as Otto Preminger, Laurence Olivier, Robert De Niro, and cult favorite Bob Clark; and
- WHEREAS: Dullea's starring role in 2001: A SPACE ODYSSEY as astronaut Dave Bowman is his best known film work, but he also appeared in many unjustly overlooked films of the 60s and 70s including David and Lisa, The Fox, and Bunny Lake Is Missing; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record in support of the Brattle Theatre Tribute Series; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That June 12, 2008 be declared Keir Dullea Day in Cambridge; and be it further
