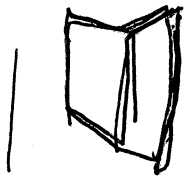

WHEREAS: In an effort to add to the number of available housing units in Cambridge, be it

ORDERED: That, when rent-controlled properties are hit by fire and are so damaged as to be rendered and declared uninhabitable, but whose owners are willing to rehabilitate them, the Inspectional Services Department should act expeditiously in granting permits and that the Rent Control Board should sign off on the premises as soon as possible, *Consider* avoiding any hearings on the matter unless the fire has been judged to be of suspicious origin and there is reason to believe that arson was the cause and that the property owner was involved in the act of said arson.
