- WHEREAS: The Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America have passed a Resolution declaring the period from November 15 through 21, 1987 as National Arts Week; and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Arts Council, eager to participate actively in National Arts Week, indicates that during that period, Massachusetts Arts Lottery funded projects include: Christian Peirce's Moroccan documentary, " The Bride Market of Imilchil " at the Cambridge Multicultural Center on Nov. 18 and 19; a holiday concert by " Musica Sacra " at Youville Hospital on Nov. 18; a poetry reading by Carl Sesar at the Sacramento Street Gallery on Nov. 20; and the presentation of new works by the Playwright's Platform at the Cambridge Center for Adult Education on Nov. 21 and 22, 1987; and
- WHEREAS: A prime event attached to National Arts Week which the Cambridge Arts Council has organized is the opening of " Current Works " , an exhibition of the recent works of Maud Morgan and Gyorgy Kepes, at the Hyatt Regency Hotel, Cambridge, MA. from November 22 - December 7, 1987; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council, following the lead of the U.S. Congress, declare the period from November 15-21, 1987 to be National Arts Week in Cambridge, and urges the people of Cambridge to take advantage of the events planned by the Cambridge Arts Council; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution and forward same as quickly as possible to Wendy-Elizabeth Stauss, Special Events, Cambridge Arts Council, 57 Inman Street, Cambridge, MA. 02139.
