ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Tax Man, Inc.

for the erection of a sign at 1876 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

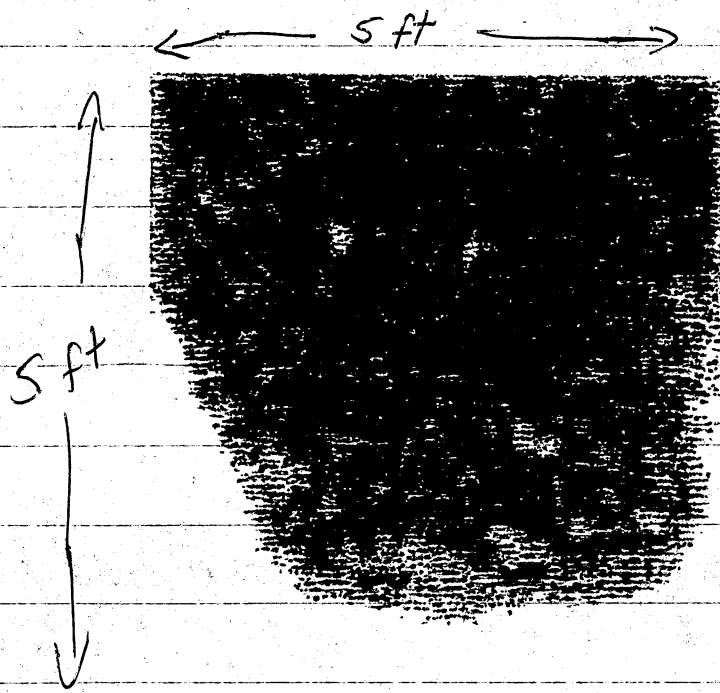

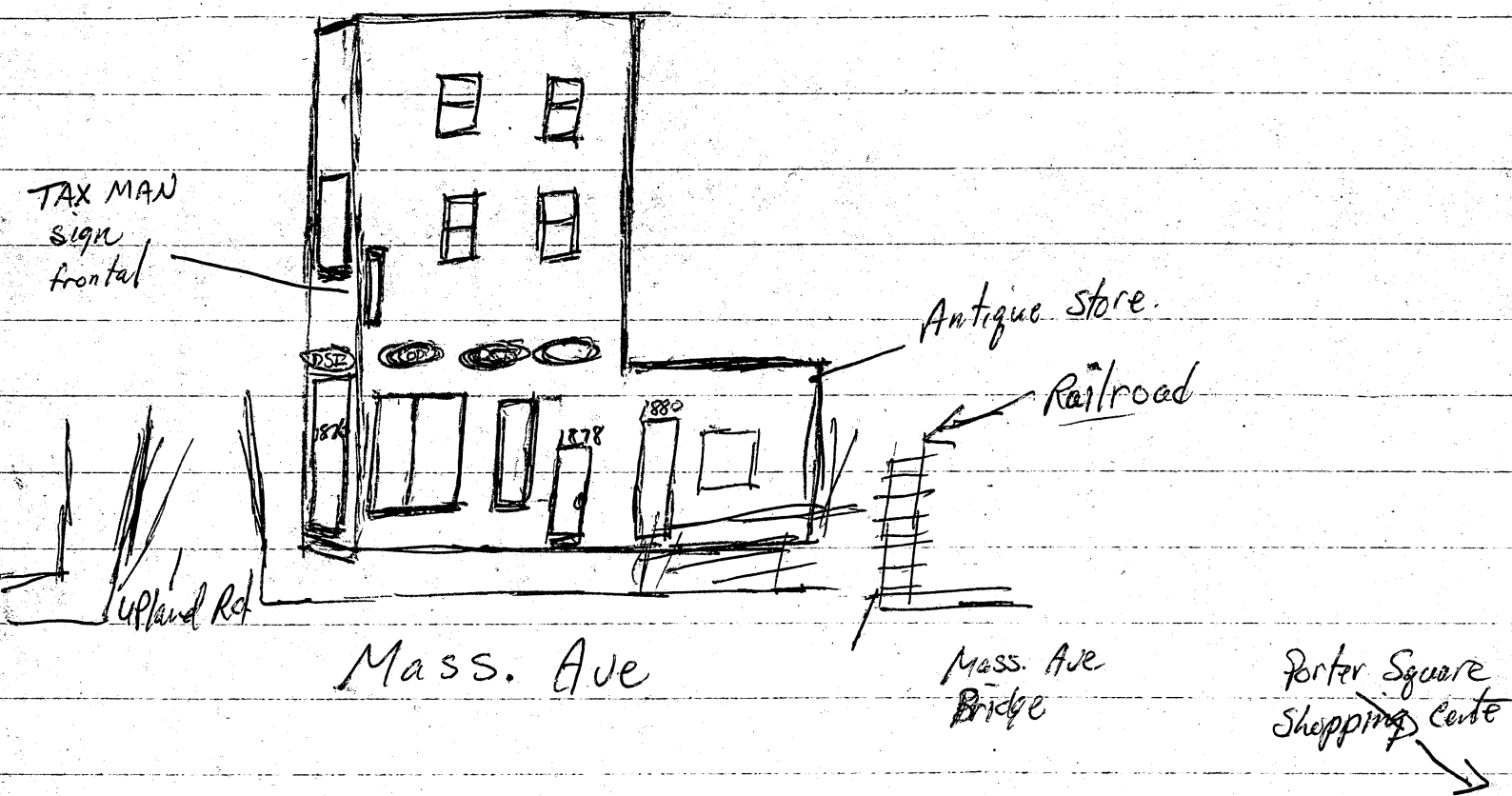
TAX MAN Sign - 1876 Mass. Ave, Cambridge
