My dear Mr. Quinn:--

Relative to my interview with you of last Thursday we offer the following proposition, and in offering this proposition would state that the use of the yard is only temporary as far as we can see. We have in mind the building of a new factory on land already acquired in South Boston, as the demands of the Government are such that it is necessary for us to have the proper space in which to do this work. We propose to enclose the piece of land next to Mead - Morrison with a fence 10 ft. high, with a proper gate for entrance, wired on the top with barbed wire.

When we get through with this land we will give you the fence and pay at the rate of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per year rent for the use of the land.

We are going ahead with the fence on this basis as we think it is a fair amount in proportion to what we are paying for vacant land in our immediate vicinity in Boston.

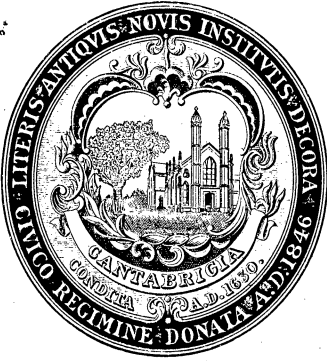

I transmit herewith a communication from E.B.Badger & Sons Co.63-75 Pitts st.Boston, dated June 15, 1918, offering to pay the sum of \$300.00 per year rent for use of a parcel of city land adjoining the Mead-Morrison property on Main st. in Cambridge, and further, to enclose this piece of land by the erection of a wire fence.

They state that they are going ahead with the fence. I have written, however, advising them that they should not do this until the City Council grants this permit for the erecting of this fence.

This seems to be a reasonable offer from a reputable business concern, and I respectfully recommend your favorable consideration of the matter at an early date.
