RESPECTFULLY, PLEASE NOTE. OVER A MONTH AGO (MAY 12, 1980) I WAS INFORMED AT THAT MONDAY NIGHT HEARING, BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT AN IMPARTIAL STRUCTURAL APPRAISAL WAS TO BE MADE ON MY HOME, MY FAMILY HOME FOR 45 YEARS. THE WORD "FEASIBILITY" WAS USED AT THE HEARING.

PLEASE NOTE, I STILL HAVEN'T HAD ANYONE DOWN TO MY HOUSE TO EXAMINE THE PROPERTY AND GIVE AN INDEPENDANT REPORT.

I WANT TO BUY THE PROPERTY AND REHAB THE HOUSE SO OTHER FAMILIES MAY MOVE IN AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. THERE IS A SEVERE EMERGENCY HOUSING SHORTAGE, NOT ONLY IN CAMBRIDGE, EVERYWHERE. PEOPLE, HAVE THE HUMAN RIGHTS TO A ROOF OVER THEIR HEAD, THE BASIC NECESSITY OF LIFE.

I THEREFORE, REPECTFULLY, ask for the PRIVILEGE OF APPEARING BEFORE YOUR HONORABLE BODY AT YOUR NEXT MEETING.
