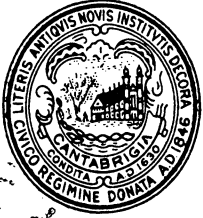

The Public Works Department plans included complete reconstruction of Cambridge Street from the Hospital to Quincy Street. This work included wheelchair ramps at all of the intersections. 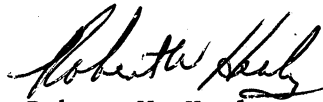
