The Public Aid Committee reports, pursuant to the rules of the City Council, that it has obtained from the Secretary of the Board of Public Welfare and from the W.P.A. Sponsor monthly reports for the month of June.

The Board of Public Welfare reports on Old Age Assistance cases four more than at the end of May, and on General Relief and Aid to Dependent Children eighty-six cases less than at the end of May. These classes of cases cost the city \$112,038.12 during the month of June, a decrease of \$13,384.29 as against the month of May.

The Sponsor's Agent reports nine hundred thirty-four persons employed during the month of June on W.P.A. projects, a decrease of one hundred three from the previous month. The cost for June was \$5,994.50 to the city; an increase of \$58.40, and \$75,759.91 to Federal Government, a decrease of \$19,662.52 from the previous month. Three white collar projects were discontinued during June. A new "Pilot Fatigue" white collar project was taken on. Nineteen new persons were taken on to W.P.A. from Welfare rolls and one hundred sixteen persons were graduated to private employment and the In-Plant and Vocational Training program, a decrease of graduates of ten from the previous month's total.
