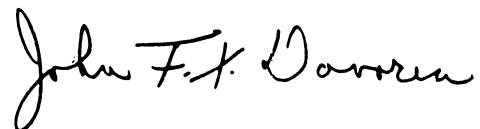

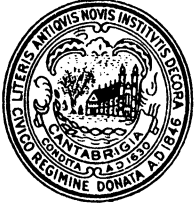

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:  
To create a Co-operative (i.e., membership controlled) Community Center which will provide:

- a. A center for concerts, forums, workshops, speakers, classes such to include but not limited to such activities as poetry readings, musical events, lectures, art exhibits, and other educational and cultural activities.
- b. A combination resource center and library to index and make accessible small press, magazines, and books which are otherwise obscure as well as records, video tapes, films and other media-type products.
- c. To provide at the disposal of the members of the corporation and the local community and in accordance with the wishes of the membership (as outlined in the by-laws) space for events and activities which are deemed educational or of cultural significance.
- d. To provide a carefully selected stock of aural, visual, and written materials such to include but not limited to films, video tapes, records, books, magazines, and other publications for sale which encourage the multi-faceted development of individuals in the membership and community.
- e. To establish and maintain a comfortable reading-room to be used by the community in accordance with policy as determined by the membership and in the by-laws.

And to participate in, assist in, and encourage other community related projects in accordance with policy as determined by the membership and in the by-laws.

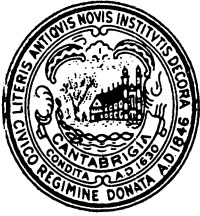

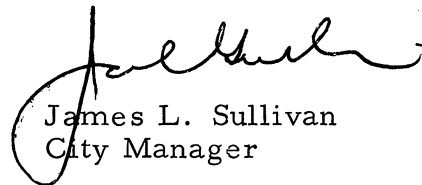
