- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Edward J. Boyle, late Cambridge native and long time businessman; and
- WHEREAS: Edward attended local schools and was an avid sports buff, who refereed college football and basketball games, where he soon became known for his agility and expertise on the field and basketball court; and
- WHEREAS: Edward, in 1948 became one of the first referees hired by the newly formed National Basketball Association and at his retirement in 1955 he was honored at the Boston Garden for his service to college and professional basketball; and
- WHEREAS: Throughout his sport and professional career, Edward was the recipient of numerous awards, such as Outstanding Catholic Layman for his dedication to youth and for his outstanding contributions to Por Cristo, an organization of area physicians who travel to Latin America to treat children; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Florence Boyle and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Boyle on behalf of the entire City Council.
