- WHEREAS: There are serious traffic problems on Memorial Drive particularly at the intersections of Western Avenue, and River Street; and
- WHEREAS: The congestion resulting from these traffic problems leads to many motorists deciding to cut through Cambridgeport on Putnam Avenue and other local streets; and
- WHEREAS: The closing of the Ford dealership may allow for more creative solutions to this problem; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Traffic Department and the Community Development Department to confer and to develop a comprehensive plan for the traffic problems in this area; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That said plan should consider such as extending Blackstone Street to Memorial Drive, among other solutions; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Traffic Department and the Community Development Department should utilize outside resources with an interest in helping to solve this problem as part of their comprehensive plan.
