

The following is an extract from the Records of the
City of Cambridge, under date of Nov. 16, 1853:-

"Ordered, That due notice be given to owners of
land bounded on a frontage leading from King
new street and bounded on the south side fronted by
the Atlantic Ocean, that this land also made on the
premises on Saturday the first day of December next at
four o'clock P.M. for the purpose of laying out a public
highway, there be given in evidence map then and then
affixed and then cause if any they have any such
disputing should not be delayed."

The following is an extract from said Records, under
date of Dec. 1, 1853:-

"The Mayor and Aldermen met by special appointment
at the junction of Main and Thayer streets, and there
after viewing the premises, with reference to
viewing the same, the Mayor proceeded to view for the
said object Thayer street opposite the College premises,
and also a street or way leading from Thayer street
and bounded in front by the Atlantic Ocean, after

viewing the premises and hearing remarks from various parties then present, the Board adjourned to meet at 7 o'clock P.M. of the same date."
