At the meeting of January 25, 1996, the New Bedford City Council, acting on a motion introduced by Councillor at Large Brian K. Gomes, voted to send a follow-up letter to every city and town in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts that has NOT responded to its first letter of August, 1995, asking for support in requesting the state legislative delegation to re-write the state mandatory one year sentence for possession of an illegal firearm to a mandatory two year sentence.

The City Council believes that guns are a major problem in our State and that the gun laws should be more strict.
