Dear Councillors:

Last spring, inspired by the City Council resolutions of March 16 and March 30, a group of Cambridge citizens who share the Council's concern about the dangers of nuclear warfare to the people of Cambridge, formed the Cambridge Peace Education Project. We agreed, at that time, to:

1) assist the Civil Defense director of Cambridge in preparing a CD brochure that would accord with the Council's mandate of March 16;

2) assist City Hall in disseminating and encouraging careful study of that brochure by as many citizens as possible;

3) assist the School Department, especially the Social Studies Coordinator and the teachers with whom she is working, in gathering materials and community resources appropriate for a peace curriculum, and serve as a support group for the teachers who are developing and using that curriculum.

We have enjoyed working with City Council members and other city officials to draft the new Civil Defense brochure, Cambridge and Nuclear Weapons. It has been a rewarding and supportive experience. Now that the brochure has been printed, we will continue to assist with its dissemination and thoughtful consideration. In addition, we will continue to support peace education in the Cambridge public schools.

Most important, we wish to compliment you on your efforts as our city representatives, and to let you know that you have made us proud to be citizens of the city of Cambridge, Massachusetts.
