WHEREAS: The Piltch Family has been an energetic, resourceful presence in Cambridge since 1907, when Rebecca Andelman, who came from Roumania to Cambridge in 1905, married Hyman Piltch who came to Cambridge from Poland in 1903; and

WHEREAS: Hyman and Rebecca had six children, Samuel, Iris, Maurice Roy, Eugene, Bernice and Sylvia, all of whom were born in Cambridge at home on Webster Avenue and Willow Street and educated in the Cambridge Schools; and

WHEREAS: Over the years, all six Piltch children made strong contributions of their services to the community of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Through their involvement in their neighborhood, Sylvia came to be known as the "Mayor" of Dana Street and Rebecca as the "Bobbie" (Jewish Grandma) of Dana Street; and

WHEREAS: Among her many contributions, Sylvia became President of Cambridge Auxiliary #35 of the Jewish War Veterans of America (J.W.V.A.), was the youngest Department President of the J.W.V.A., served as an outstanding National President in 1958, all while she pursued a successful career as a physical therapist, became Director of the Physical Therapy Department of Cambridge Hospital where she served with such distinction that upon her retirement, the Physical Therapy Department was named in her honor; and

WHEREAS: Sylvia has made her mark and continues to do so, while Iris, who passed away in 1994, made her mark in other equally valued ways; she was a "legend in her time", and is much missed by everyone she touched; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That in appreciation of the years of contributions of the Piltch Family to their community, The City Council hereby designates the intersection of Cambridge Street and Dana Street as "Piltch Square."
