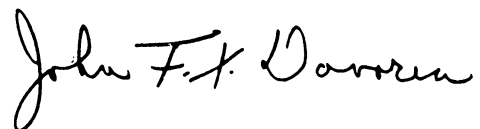

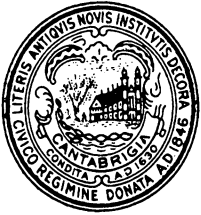

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) and in furtherance of said purposes but without limiting the foregoing, to engage in, or assist others, in engaging in the education and treatment of children who are or seem to be psychotic or mentally retarded; to carry out, sponsor or encourage the carrying out of scientific investigation of techniques of remediation of such children, and to operate facilities for the education or treatment thereof.

And in general to exercise the powers granted by Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 180, as now in force or as hereafter amended, in any jurisdiction within or without the United States.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officer or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

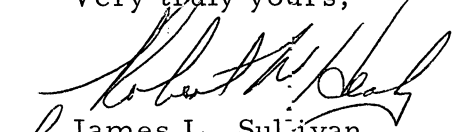
