WHEREAS: This City Council learned of the passing of Anders T. Anderson on August 25, 1977 at the age of 70 years, and

WHEREAS: Anders T. Anderson had an outstanding career in the City of Cambridge where he compiled an outstanding record as a football player at Rindge Tech, prior to his attendance at St. Anselm's in 1926 and later achieved national recognition as a stalwart lineman under Coach Joe McKenney at Boston College in the 1927-1931 era, and

WHEREAS: Anders T. Anderson had a long and varied career in the municipal service as a City Councillor in 1934-1935, prior to his appointment as a Deputy Sealer of Weights and Measures and was promoted to head that department on March 15, 1955 and continued in the service of the city until his retirement in April of 1972, now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council, in session assembled on Wednesday, September 7, 1977, record our admiration to this dedicated official for his achievements in the municipal service and on the athletic field, and be it further

RESOLVED: That a copy of this resolution be spread on the records of this City Council and a suitably engrossed copy be presented to his wife, Helen M. Rigby Anderson in testimony of our sorrow at the loss of a dear friend and colleague who represented the best in public service.
