Arthur F. Blanchard was a member of the Cambridge City Council during the years 1916 and 1917 and served the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in the years 1918 and 1923-1928 as a State Representative and culminated his political career by being elected State Senator representing the City of Cambridge from 1937 to 1942, and

Arthur F. Blanchard was a man of many talents, the author of several plays and the editor of a weekly column in the old Cambridge Chronicle and the author of many satirical verses for the Boston Herald and other publications, and
