

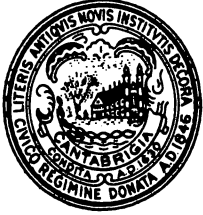
The above transfer is needed to cover the cost for expanded computerized streetlist operations.



To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached transfer of \$12,000 from the Election Commission's Salary and Wages Account to the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account is necessary in order to cover the costs of a pilot program for the computerization of the annual Street Listing.
