- WHEREAS: From 2003 – 2006 Joseph taught at the Kennedy Longfellow School; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph also coached the Girls' Cross Country, Indoor and Outdoor Track at CRLS from 1973 – 1990; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph was the Boston Globe Coach of the Year in 1985 and was inducted into the Massachusetts State Coaches Hall of Fame in 1996; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph coached the Women's Track Team at MIT from 1990 – 1998; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its appreciation to Joseph Sousa for his many years of dedicated service to the citizens and to the City of Cambridge and wish him much happiness in his retirement; and be it further
