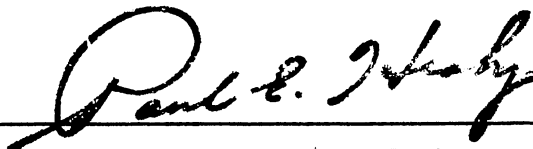
COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN
