To The Honorable, The City Council:

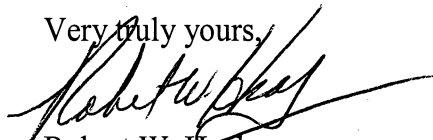
In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 02-36, regarding a report on safety concerns at the intersection of Harvard and Dana Streets, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan Clippinger reports the following:

The Department is evaluating the intersection, which will include the following steps:

- The accident reports for the intersection have been requested from the Police Department. Once received, we will analyze the information to determine what the pattern is and what the possible causes of the safety problems are.
- Turning movement counts in the am and pm peak and mid day will be taken the week of May 13 – 17.
- Once the accident and turning movement counts have been reviewed, the Engineering staff will do a site inspection.

An email was sent to Ms. Rubin and Mr. Stankiewicz on April 27, 2002 explaining what the Department is and notified them that the analysis will take 6 to 12 weeks. The Department will remain in contact with the residents and the City Council once the review is complete.
