WHEREAS: The arrest was possible because of the cooperation of the victim, a strong effort to notify the neighborhood through community based policing, and the efforts of three bicycle police officers, Alex Collazo, Phillip Chu, and Buckowe Yam, who identified and arrested the perpetrator; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record commending the Cambridge Police Department for the quick community based response to this crime; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record commending Officers Alex Collazo, Phillip Chu, and Buckowe Yam for their role in quickly apprehending the perpetrator of this crime; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward suitably engrossed copies of this resolution to Police Commissioner Ronnie Watson and Officers Alex Collazo, Phillip, Chu, and Buckowe Yam on behalf of the entire City Council.
