WHEREAS: The Cambridge Voter Coalition formed in March, 1984 to support the continuous work of the Cambridge Election Commission and has taken as its goal the registration of every eligible voter in Cambridge by means of a citywide campaign in every neighborhood; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council declare July 29th through August 21st, 1984 "Cambridge Voter Action Days" during which registration and voter awareness will be promoted citywide; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager encourage City departments to promote Voter Registration and awareness among employees, clients and all cooperating agencies.
