COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Director of Traffic and Parking and the Chief of Police to restructure the street cleaning program so that cars will be allowed to park on a street immediately after the street has been cleaned as opposed to the current ban on parking during the hours of 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. on those streets designated for cleaning; and be it further

ORDERED: That particular attention to this problem be given to the immediate area of a funeral home when a funeral or wake is in progress.
