Belmont Street between Holworthy and Cushing Street
Columbia Street between Washington Street and Bishop Allen Drive
Western Avenue between Green Street and River Street; and

WHEREAS: This is a danger to all people who use this area; and

WHEREAS: The city has an ordinance which requires the owner to attend to these matters within a reasonable time; and

WHEREAS: The owner has continually failed to do so; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the City Solicitor to notify the owner of this property that residents are complaining about this situation and that it is the intent of the City Manager to be sure that after the next storm this property is checked on to see if it complies with the ordinance governing the removal of snow and ice and that failure to do so will result in a fine; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consult with the Mt. Auburn and Cambridge Hospitals to determine the number of senior citizens who are injured by falling on icy sidewalks and report back to this City Council.
