ORDERED: That the following transfer be made in the General Fund of the City of Cambridge:

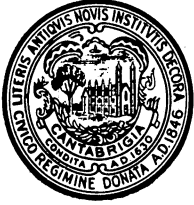

I request an Appropriation Transfer as follows:

Under the Community Development Block Grant application to the Department of HUD, \$20,000 was earmarked for the development of a Human Services Component with the Community Development Department. The majority of this amount was to pay for a full time staff person to coordinate human services activities with the other departmental activities. The staff person, Ms. Sally Jelenik, submitted her resignation to the department effective September 1, 1975. The department pursued and acquired the services of Ms. Linda Broderick, through the Intergovernmental Personnel Act of 1970.

Ms. Linda Broderick has many years experience working for Federal and State Agencies in the Human Services Field. It was felt that the City would be further ahead by contracting for the services of this consultant under the Intergovernmental Personnel Act of 1970 as we would secure a person with wide and extensive experience for half her salary.

It should be noted the Department does not intend to eliminate this position but plans on leaving it vacant during the terms of this Consultant Contract.


