I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$70,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$44,683.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$23,567.00) and Travel and Training Account (\$1,750.00) from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health's Tobacco Control Program.
